

CARE OF YOUR PET FOLLOWING SURGERY OR HOSPITALIZATION

Pet's Name	Procedure	Discharge Date
Proper Restraint	Please protect your pet when leaving the hospital by using either a leash or carrier. Do not allow your pet to become overly active or excited when you pick him/her up from the hospital.	
Food and water	With the excitement of returning home after surgery, your pet may be inclined to drink and eat excessively which may result in vomiting. To avoid this, we recommend restricting access to water for an hour or so until your pet has quieted down. Then allow only small amounts of food and water for the first eight (8) hours. Normal feeding may resume the next day.	
Diet	 Diet can be very important to recovery, please followinstructions: > Feed you pet his/her regular diet. > Feed multiple smaller meals times a discrete for the special diet: 	
Eliminations	Many patients may not have a bowel movement for 24 to 35 hours after surgery. This is normal.	
Exercise and	Patients recovering from surgery or illness should have limited Activity exercise. Avoid giving your pet access to stairs or other situations that may lead to injury. Due to the effects of anesthesia, ne/she may be groggy for 12 hours.

Sutures	Discourage your pet from licking or chewing at the sutures. Please check the incision daily for any swelling, redness, or discharge. If sutures appear irritated or infected, notify us	

immediately.
